The Director moved to the Antelope Valley in 1986 and has lived in Palmdale since 1997. He has served in leadership positions at local, regional and state levels. For more than 30 years, he has been educating English-language learners in the Lancaster School District and was its Classified Employee of the Year in 2002. He was first elected to the Board in November 2011. His current term expires in November 2020.

Director Alvarado represents Division 1, which roughly borders Avenue P to the north, Avenue R to the south, 35th Street to the east and Highway 14 to the west.
