vacant seat for half of a full term. He maintained his seat after no one challenged him in the November 2022 election. His current term will end in December.

Part owner of Antelope Valley Harley-Davidson, Director Kellerman has been on the Antelope Valley Sheriff's Boosters for more than 16 years and is the President of the California Harley-Davidson Dealers Association.
